| 6. | Treasurer's Report: Cathy Mess | Report attached The accountant is currently working on the financials. Once finalized, the report will be attached to meeting minutes and distributed to members via our website. |
| 7. | Director of Skating Report (Operational): Lynnell Moss | Lynnell introduced Kaylee Marcoux as the coaches' representative. The Coaches' Representative is elected by the coaches to represent them. The club has experienced significant growth over the past 3-4 years. Coaching staff has also grown from 4 coaches to 17 this year. The growth of the club has slowed during the past year and appears to have reached a plateau with membership numbers currently at 754 (registered participants). ACS is very fortunate to have good communication between coaches and Board of Directors. Coaching fees included in program costs pay for necessities. There are a few salaried positions within the club. Most coaches bill independently. Lynnell discussed the Bridge Program for CanSkate/Figure Skating. This is important element in the development of skaters. Coaches are highly invested in the success of athletes (what-ever that success may look like for each individual skater.) Lynnell thanked our amazing Dry Land Coaches for the contributions they make to the programs. ASC has been participating in Ice User Meetings with the City of Airdrie. The outcome of the meetings will be a new ice user policy for the City. The policy may result in new opportunities for the Airdrie Skating Club. |
| 8. | Test Chair Report: Jacki Martel | Jacki provided an overview of testing for 2016-2017 including out of club test days. Three ASC Coaches became certified through Skate Canada to complete Star 1 to 5 testing. 50 tests were passed in-house in the past 3 months. In-house testing is a big win for the club.
